

IN CHESTNUTHILL TOWNSHIP RECYCLING IS AS EASY AS



<u>ONE</u>

Rinse recyclable food and beverage containers to keep insects away

TWO

Set aside a special container for your recyclables at home. Container can be something as simple as a plastic grocery bag, a sturdy cardboard box, crate, or bucket

THREE

Go to the Transfer Station and place your recyclables in the designated containers

CORRUGATED CARDBOARD

Place FLATTENED box in designated container

NEWSPAPER, MAGAZINES, CATALOGS, JUNKMAIL, OFFICE PAPER, BOOKS

Place in designated container
Remove hard covers and metal spiral from notebooks

BULKY METAL ITEMS (Ask Attendant for details)

PLASTICS - BOTTLES, JUGS AND FOOD CONTAINERS
Place RINSED plastic in designated container

RIGID PLASTICS Place CLEAN plastic in designated container

CAR BATTERIES Place in designated location. Place alkaline (eg: AAA & AA) batteries in with regular garbage

STYROFOAM Place Styrofoam in designated containers

PLASTIC BAGS Place bags in designated container

ALUMINUM CANS & TIN (BI-METAL)

Place RINSED cans in designated container

GLASS (All Colors)

Place RINSED glass in designated container NO Windows, Mirrors, Dishes or Light Bulbs Do NOT break glass bottles or jars

USED MOTOR OIL & ANTIFREEZE (Ask attendant for details)

USED CLOTHING Place CLEAN clothes in Salvation Army Container or Boy Scout Troup 98

FLOURESCENT LIGHT BULBS (Ask Attendant for details)

SENSITIVE DOCUMENT PAPER SHREDDING (Ask Attendant for details)

Electronics/Appliance Recycling

Electronics and Appliance recycling is available for residents at the Chestnuthill Township Transfer Station. Any special needs resident may call the Township Monday thru Friday



8:00am-4:00pm at 570-992-7247, if they require assistance with an item. (This program is limited to two items per month)

Yard Waste

Residents of Chestnuthill are encouraged to bring their tree trimmings & leaves to the Compost Facility for composting.

Contractors must pay the township \$5 per cubic yard in order to bring leaf/yard waste to the facility

Compost "when available" may be taken by Township residents for their personal use at no charge (Residents are responsible for loading their own compost). **No Contractors!**

How to manage paint related waste

Latex Paint Disposal:

Latex paint is not hazardous and can be disposed of with regular waste.

Step 1

Pour paint into absorbent material Shredded newspaper or kitty litter.

Step 3

Dispose of dried paint in trash.

Step 2

Allow it to completely dry

Step 4

Recycle the empty, dry container.

Oil-based Paint Disposal:

Oil-based paint, stains and varnishes are hazardous and <u>should not</u> be disposed of with household waste, if possible.



Residential / Non-Profit Loading is Now Available! Saturdays Only

Resident can visit the Chestnuthill Township Compost Facility (3143 Hillcrest Dr.) and have their compost/mulch material loaded for a small fee.

Fees for loading **Mulch** are as follows: First 3 yards or less—\$10.00, each additional 3 yards—\$10.00.

Fess of loading **Compost** are as follows: First 3 yards or less—\$20.00, each additional 3 yards—\$20.00.

Non-profits may also use the loading service and will receive a 50% discount!
